### 1) What are the current high school requirements for college?

- Also, check the college admission department of the college your student is interested in attending. For example, prior to entering high school, select 3-4 different colleges that your student may potentially be interested in attending. Contact them and ask for college admission requirements.

### 2) Which of these classes (from the list of high school requirements) does Timothy now offer?

- 5 Science Classes: Physical Science, Biology, Chemistry, Human Anatomy, Physics
- 3 math classes: Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2,
- 4 English classes: Introduction Literature and Composition, Composition, World Literature & American Literature; some years British Literature may be offered.
- Spanish 1 and 2; ASL (Sign Language)
- 3 History classes: World Geography (can be counted as an elective), World History, US History

### 3) What HS credits can be earned in 8th grade?

- Physical Science, Spanish 1, and Algebra 1

### 5) What testing is REQUIRED for graduation? (Assuming you're entering college) Do you have to take the Iowa in 12th grade?

- Again, these questions are best answered by contacting the college admissions office of colleges your student is interested in attending. Begin this process as early as 8<sup>th</sup> grade.
- Kennesaw State requires an acceptably summation exam (12<sup>th</sup> grade year or within last 12 months. Examples of Summation Exams: Iowa Test of Educational Development, California Achievement Test, and Stanford Achievement Test.)
